# A LETTER FROM OUR PRESIDENT

# 2022 LIST OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 1) We saw our first graduation at the accredited TBI seminary in Uganda with 30 students taking theology degrees! Our 7 non-accredited sites in 5 countries (Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda, and Burundi trained over 500 students in theology.
- 2) We hosted our first-ever non-accredited classes at the newly purchased campus in Kigali, Rwanda!
- 3) Our pilot "bridging programs" were recognized by the National Council for Higher Education in Uganda to help foreign pastors and other pastors who never finished high school to have a chance to start in higher education.
- 4) We started a grant and mentoring program for a new church plant led by TBI students in Eastern Uganda.
- 5) We launched the Trinity Network for Church Planting and Church Health to provide resources, opportunities, and continuing education for our graduates. This will include mentoring church planter graduates and sponsoring church health seminars for students of TBI.
- 6) We hired Godfrey Seuya to be our new country coordinator for Tanzania, a wonderful, reformed pastor with a heart for theological education in his country. We also hired Francis Owoyesigire to be our new Country Director for Uganda, a man with a passion for church planting and good theology.
- 7) We completed and moved into our new Mission HQ in Dahlonega, Georgia!
- 8) We purchased 5 acres of land in Tanzania to be used for a future accredited seminary.
- 9) We built a new library and sickbay at our TBI Uganda campus.
- 10) We saw new board members added, many new partnering churches and individuals added, and our prayer meetings have expanded both in numbers and frequency!
