- 6 Give thanks to God that Dr. Luiz of the Presbyterian Church of Brazil, his wife Daniella and their son Samuel have moved to Kigali, Rwanda. Please pray for them as they get settled there and begin their missionary ministry.
- 7 Pray for peace along the eastern border of Congo around Goma. Both Ugandan and Rwandan troops are involved in heavy ongoing fighting.
- 8 Praise the Lord that full funding to renovate the kitchen in Kapchorwa has been received. Pray for the safety of the work crew from Goshen Construction Company who will be constructing the new kitchen.
- 9 Give thanks to God that TBI-Kapchorwa’s relationship with its Muslim neighbors has significantly improved. Pray that TBI will continue have good relationships with our neighbors in Kapchorwa, Uganda; Kigali, Rwanda and Shia District, Tanzania.
- 10 Praise God for the good amount of rain He provided during February-March while the five-week course was in session. The rain replenished the campus water tanks for the students’ consumption. Less money was spent on the city water.
- 11 Pray for the necessary wisdom, strength and encouragement for those who are working on the TBI study guides for the bachelor’s degree classes.
