In Northern Uganda, we have just finished TBI classes in a refugee center. And for the first time ever, we hosted conference classes in Mombasa, Kenya, a port city with some 900,000 residents.

We are busy, taking what you have invested, and using it for the glory of God and for making disciples. Thank you for cheerfully investing in eternity. Most people do not make investing in the Kingdom a priority. I have been a pastor for about fifty years. In that time, I have had many people come to me and share one or more of their sins. But there is one sin that no one has ever confessed to me: greed. This is the sin that we do not see in our lives; this sin is often behind the failure of the church to reach the nations of the world with the Gospel. We live in a world where very smart people get up early to convince you that you do not have what you deserve or need. Each day we hear something like this: "Do you want to be happy and fulfilled? Then you must have this; you owe it to yourself...." Voddie Baucham puts it this way, "God is not against you having things. He's against things having you."

## TWO EXCITING TCWM DEVELOPMENTS IN TANZANIA AND KENYA!

There are two developments I just witnessed within the last two weeks when I was in Tanzania and Kenya that I am excited about and want to share with you.

1) When I was in Tanzania two weeks ago, we were working on the official ministry registration application which was necessary for government approval. We were a bit frustrated because it had sat for three months with no response from the government. On a certain morning I said to Godfrey, our country director, "Brother, we just need to pray!" So we did just that. The very next day we had a breakthrough. When our lawyer checked the status of the application, it had changed from the "Analysis" stage to the "Finalization" stage, which is the most important step. Now we need you to pray for the final two signatures needed on our ministry certificate in order for TCWM to be officially registered in Tanzania! Please pray!

2) The next week after Tanzania, I flew over to Mombasa, Kenya for the launch of a brand new TBI teaching site and pastor's conference. This launch was a success with almost 80 participants and very cooperative and eager local site coordinators. The chairman of the Mombasa Pastor's Fellowship, a highly respected local pastor, was so impressed with the depth of the teachings that he decided then and there that him and one other man would go to Uganda to attend our accredited seminary this spring!
