PRIORITIES FOR 2023

What are your priorities for 2023? Perhaps you want to save money, lose weight, or spend more time with your family. Those all sound like noble priorities, but there is a big problem: those are priorities that *you* have chosen.

A better question is this: *What are God's priorities for you and all of His children?* God has given us His Word and His Spirit so that we will know His priorities. So, before you make your grand plans, first think about your Creator and His priorities for you.

Jesus taught that we are to seek first the Kingdom of God. In Scripture, we are given the Great Commandment and the Great Commission. These are major commands given to you, they are part of your surrendering your life to the Lordship of Christ.

So let me challenge you. Think about how God has made you; consider your gifts and resources, your experiences in life, how you have served in the past, and your passions. What can you do in 2023 to advance the Kingdom of God, to express your love for God and your neighbor? What can you do to reach the lost of this world with the Good News of the Gospel?

TCWM works each day with its eyes particularly on Christ's priority commanded in the Great Commission. Our priority is making disciples, teaching them to obey all that Christ has commanded. We express it this way, "We create seminaries, which create pastors, which create churches, which create disciples."

Our priority is the discipleship of the nations, particularly Uganda, Kenya, Rwanda, Tanzania, and Burundi. As Doug mentioned, these next few months our focus will be on Rwanda. We see this as part of the priority given by Christ in the Great Commission. The government of Rwanda has closed thousands of churches because the pastors have little or no training. We are determined to have an accredited program in Rwanda that equips pastors to make disciples and plant churches.

We need to get started. Here are the immediate needs for February:

- \$6,600 for beds and mattresses.



- \$35,000 for matching a grant from Mission to the World; with this, we can use the \$70,000 to build a small hybrid dorm which is enough to begin accreditation in Rwanda before these pastors are ejected from their pulpits.
- \$5,000 for other renovations in Rwanda, including plumbing, electrical, roofing, painting, and temporary showers.

Doug and I believe this is the time to press forward. Will you invest in this kingdom-building work in 2023 and make it a priority? If you are led to invest in these new opportunities, please go to our website, www.trinitycwm.com/donate.
