We had the joy of launching the new PCU church plant in Ngenge (near Kapchorwa, Eastern Uganda) through door-to-door evangelism and open-air meeting crusades. We saw many profess faith in Christ, but counted 6 serious converts who showed up to the launch worship service Sunday morning. We also had the joy of relaunching the original Kapchorwa PCU church as a RE-plant, "New Hope PCU." This was also done through door-to-door and crusades in Kapchorwa town. People respond to the direct Gospel in amazing numbers in Uganda, and very sincerely as well, in this revival culture. Both of these church plants are being pastored by a Trinity Biblical Institute alumni and a TBI teacher, so this is the fruit and product of our TBI seminary in Uganda!

The third week we preached in a church in Gulu on Sunday morning (northern Uganda) and then came back to Kampala (the capital of Uganda) for ministry in a local church and school and other ministry meetings. Thank you for all your prayers and support for this trip and for TCWM. Our global vision is to create seminaries, which create pastors, which create churches, which create disciples, in Africa, to the Glory of God.

Rwanda July 2023

Last month while Doug and his family were in Uganda, we also sent a team to Rwanda! This team included our office manager, our board chairman, TCWM donors, and members of a supporting church.

While in Rwanda, we hosted a medical mission outreach at our TBI Rwanda campus. We had the opportunity to serve approximately 1,600 people through this two-day outreach! Our Rwanda campus being relatively new, we were thankful for this opportunity to reach our neighbors and care for those in close proximity to our campus.

The second week, our team got to serve with World Witness at Nyabihu Christian Academy (NCA). One of our team members, Nancy Sober, hosted a teacher training workshop to discuss biblical integration in education, and Charlie King taught local pastors about biblical manhood. We helped with repairs and renovations to this children's school, and visited homes carrying the Gospel message of Jesus Christ.

The final week, Charlie King and David Mullens both taught at the TBI Conference, teaching evangelism and discipleship. About 70 students came, sat under their teaching, and participated in great discussion about sin and the doctrines of grace. Please be praying for these students as they continue to think through and apply what they learned.

The Lord is at work in the beautiful country of Rwanda, and we are thankful for the opportunity to serve Him and His people. Thank you for giving through TCWM for the Kingdom of God!
